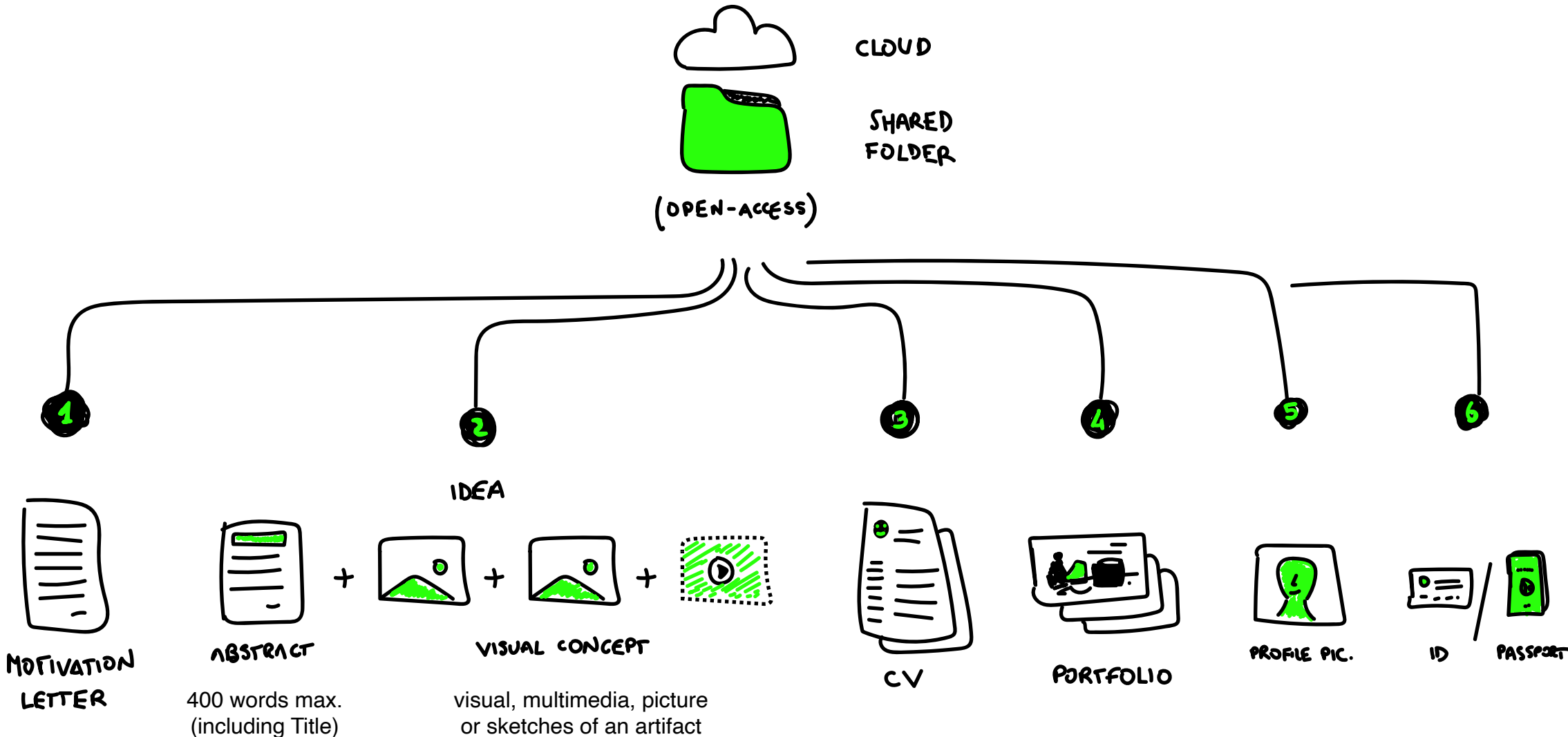
You can apply:

A. if your Nationality is one of the 8 Countries mentioned above
B. if you are resident in one of the 8 Countries mentioned above

WHY SHOULD I APPLY?

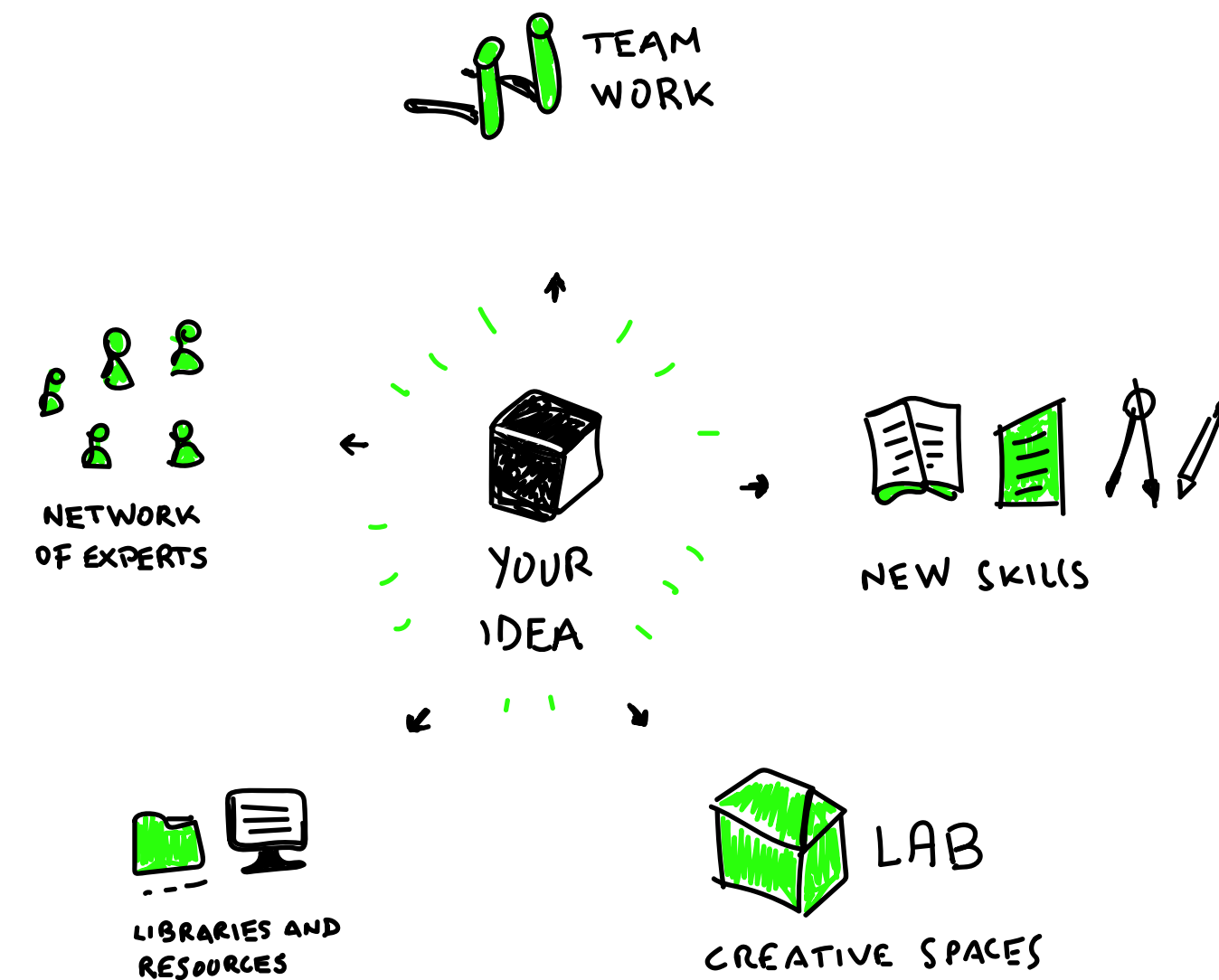
IDEAS come TRUE!

- academic **network** to exploit



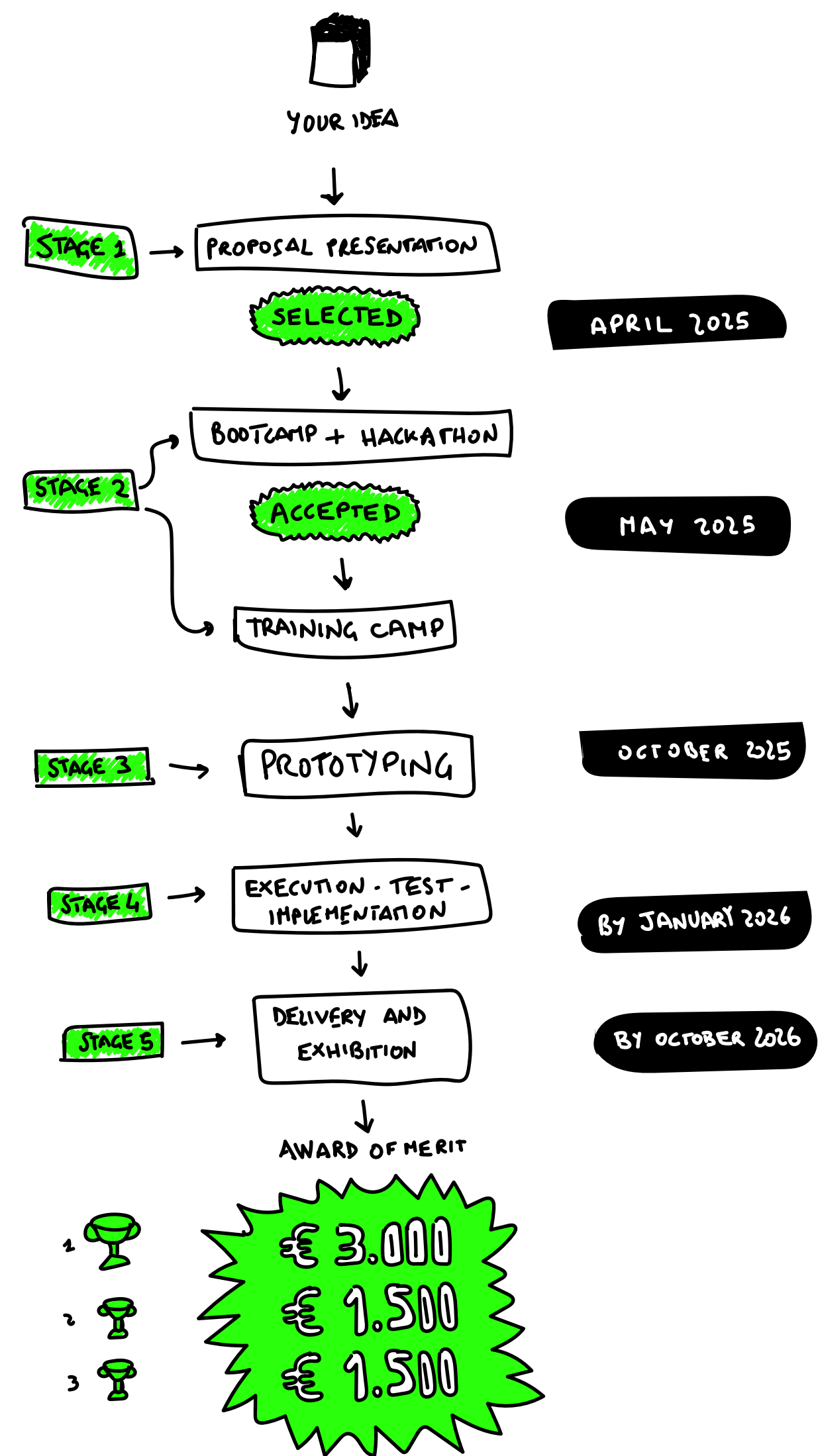
WHAT IF I'LL BE SELECTED
